Division I

Competitive group of teams that keep score and all play will be governed by the FIFA laws of the game

Other Program information

LOCATION

- The games will be held primarily at the Hagerstown Fairgrounds.
- Locations and directions will be provided once season starts

GAME DAY/GAME TIME

- Games will be held on Sunday
- Games will start approximately at 1:00 Sunday afternoon.

PRACTICES

- Team Managers and Players digression
- Weekly pickup scrimmages will be scheduled as time permits, usually one day a week

REGISTRATION

- Full league fees are due at the time of registration
- Copy of Photo ID or a league photo is required to register
- **TWO** signed Registration forms and a signed code of conduct should be returned to the registrar in a timely manner to ensure a spot on a team.
